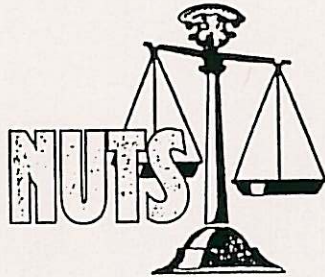

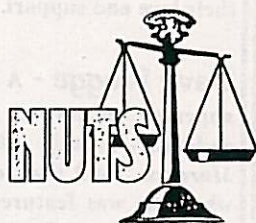

PROFILES

Tom Csepregi - Mr. Csepregi has been with the Joliet Drama Guild for many years, and can often be found building sets or working backstage.
